

Biblical Chronological Reading Plan

Layout of the Readings

Although no chronological reading plan is absolutely certain, the following plan is my attempt to place the biblical books and events in a close order. Some readings may seem to duplicate each other. The Holy Spirit inspired the writers to often give a slightly different point of view of the same events. By grouping them together, the reader can more easily see the similarities and differences.

Since the readings are numbered, not dated, you can start your reading at any time of the year, not just on January 1. The sheets don't have dated readings also so that there are no guilty feelings of "getting behind" nor of having to have a double-reading day to "catch up," should you miss any days. If you miss a day, it's probably best just to pick up where you left off, with the next reading only. Otherwise, you may come to be discouraged, which is the opposite purpose for which these sheets were created!

In attempting to place the events together, some readings are shorter and some are longer. Feel free to add an additional reading or break up a reading as you are able. This study is for your

blessing and growth. Use it as God gives you the opportunity and ability.

When you complete a reading, write the date on the sheet next to the reading. That'll give you a good sense of your progress as time rolls on.

As you work through the Bible you'll be blessed, as you have a good bit of Scripture wash over you each day.
